

SENIOR CHECKLIST FOR CRIMINOLOGY MAJORS

√ Degree Program

Your official (finalized) degree program for your desired major and/or minor must be on file. If not, you will not graduate with it. You can declare majors and minors at University Hall 109.

√ Apply for Graduation

An 'Application for Graduation' form should be completed online at MyMissouristate.edu under the Academics Tab. Click 'Apply for Graduation' in the Commencement box. This information should be filed after registering for your last semester of classes. The application for graduation must be filed by the Registrar's deadline for your name to appear in the Commencement program. If your graduation date changes from the original form you filed, you will need to fill out a new application for graduation.

√ Exit Exam

Take the University Exit Exam (GEN 499) after you have completed 102 hours. This is not taken for credit but is required for graduation. This exam can be taken any time prior to finals week. For more information: <http://www.missouristate.edu/assessment/exitexam.htm>

√ Graduating Senior Information

√ Financial Aid Exit Interview

Required for students with loans. Check with the Office of Financial Aid for details or go to <http://www.missouristate.edu/financialaid/loans/loancounseling.htm> to conduct your exit interview online.

√ Degree Audit

You may view your degree audit at any time at MyMissouristate.edu under the Academics tab. The audit will outline your remaining requirements. Be sure to refresh ('Process New' button) your audit after you have registered for your final semester. All requirements should either have a green check mark (completed) or one blue squiggle line (currently in progress). Contact your advisor if there is something missing or if you have questions.

Degree Audits with the latest grades are available within two weeks of commencement.
